School & Home Applicable Remedial Program

SHARP (School & Home Applicable Remedial Program) is the flagship initiative of **IndiaAsha Foundation** that provides free remedial education and emotional support to children struggling with learning difficulties.



Unlike traditional education models that only focus on grades, **SHARP** identifies and supports children facing challenges such as:



Dyslexia

(Difficulty in reading and writing)



Dyscalculia

(Difficulty with numbers and math concepts)



Dysgraphia

(Difficulty with writing)



ADHD & Attention Difficulties

(Trouble focusing and retaining information)



Fear & Low Confidence

(Emotional barriers that hinder learning)



Through mindful teaching methods, personalized attention, & parental engagement, **SHARP** helps these children rebuild their confidence, enjoy learning again, and discover their true potential.

Why SHARP?

Every child deserves the right to learn with confidence. But for many children in rural India, especially in government schools, learning is not a joyful experience it's a struggle.



Silent Struggles

Children with learning difficulties like dyslexia, dyscalculia, dysgraphia, ADHD, and attention disorders often go unnoticed.



Low Confidence

They are labelled as “weak students” and lose interest in studies.



Dropouts & Missed Potential

Many eventually drop out, unable to cope, even though they have the intelligence and creativity to succeed.



Emotional Impact

Fear, anxiety, and low self-esteem affect not just academics, but a child's overall personality.
