- ✓ Community Engagement: English clubs, speaking challenges, and village-level competitions.

Assessment – Baseline test to identify learner levels.



Foundation Building – Practical modules on day-to-day communication.



Trainer Support – Local teachers/youth volunteers trained as facilitators.



Sustainable Practice – English clubs and community events to keep the practice alive.
